What to Look for in a Book:

- Chapter books under 200 pages with text printed slightly larger than adult books so as not to seem overwhelming;
- Books with humor that will keep your child laughing, smiling, and wanting to read more;
- Nonfiction books with illustrations and pictures which will aid in the comprehension of new information;
- Award-winners, especially Newbery Honor and Medal winners, are trustworthy options.
