every error you have.

✿ 0 fingers– too easy!

✿ 1-3 fingers– just right!

✿ 4-5 fingers– too hard for now!

What to Look for in a Book:

- Plots that your child can relate to (friendship, going to school, family issues) and encourage your child to ask questions and explore his world;
- Language that has rhyme and repetition;
- Illustrations that engage your child
- Gold, silver, or bronze stickers that indicate the books have won awards (Coretta Scott King, Newberry, Caldecott).
