- ORIGINAL BIRTH CERTIFICATE
- IMMUNIZATION RECORD
- HEARING AND VISION RESULTS (if complete)
- 3 PROOFS OR ROSEVILLE RESIDENCY (drivers license, 3 different utility bills, lease or mortgage, voter id, etc...)

ONLY vision and hearing results may be brought to school at a later date, but **MUST** be provided before school starts. **NO EXCEPTIONS.**

<p>MEDICATION Parents, this a reminder that ANY AND ALL medication, including cough drops or any over the counter medicine MUST be kept in the school office WITH a medical form on File.</p>	<p>HOMEWORK Please allow the teachers 24 hours for any homework to be gathered. Normally, if a student is expected to return to school the next day, the student should check with the teacher for missed work and he/she will be allowed the same amount of time absent to make up the work.</p>	<p>RECESS Please make sure your student is dressed appropriately for the weather. Outdoor recess will be held in the winter months if the temperature is above 10 degrees. Parents, please consider having an extra change of clothing for your child kept in their backpack. We have had to call home quite a bit for students that have gotten wet during recess.</p>

WINTER ATTIRE

As the weather gets colder, please make sure to send your child to school with a jacket, hat, gloves and snow boots/snow pants when needed. The students go out for recess everyday, unless the weather is below **10 degrees**.

PARKING

Dropping off, stopping and parking on Wellington is **STRICTLY PROHIBITED**. The police will be patrolling around the building and if someone is illegally parked, they could receive a citation. You **MUST** use the parking lot across the street. Please do not block the driveways of the surrounding homes or the bus loop.

PICK UP

Per district policy, you must present I.D. when picking up your child. If you do not provide one, we cannot release the student. They must be 18 years or older to pick up a student. Students should not be called down after 3PM for early release unless it is for a doctor or dentist appointment.

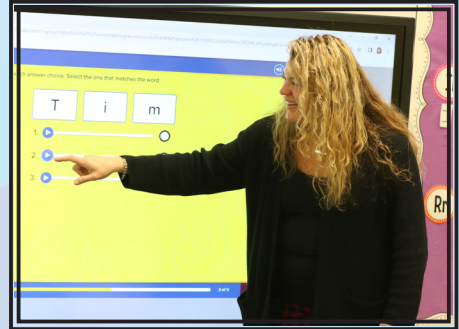
